

DAY 01: Miami, FL

Transfer to your Miami hotel and spend the afternoon discovering the South Beach, famed for its colorful art deco buildings, white sand, surfside hotels and trendsetting nightclubs.

Overnight: Best Western Atlantic Beach Resort or similar



Day 02 – Miami, FL – Orlando, FL

This morning you will head north via Palm Beach toward Kennedy Space Center where the Apollo moon missions were launched and all space shuttles lift off. A guided tour of the installation will be given. See Spaceport USA with various museums and the "Rocket Garden" with missiles from every stage of the space exploration program depict the history of the flight. The futuristic Astronauts Memorial was designed in honor of the United States astronauts who lost their lives to space exploration. Continue to Orlando in the afternoon. *(Kennedy Space Center Admission Included).*

Day 03 - Orlando



Day 04 – Orlando, FL – Savannah, GA

Day 06 – Charleston, SC – Asheville, NC

Today's journey will take you to one of the most popular mountain resorts in the East, Asheville. This resort town is divided by two rivers the Swannanoa and the French Board, and it is surrounded by the Great Smokey and Blue Ridge Mountains. Asheville is home of the Biltmore Estate, a 250-room French Renaissance style chateau built by George Washington Vanderbilt, grandson of railroad magnate, Cornelius Vanderbilt.

Day 07 – Asheville, NC – Nashville, TN

This morning's drive will take you alongside the Great Smokey Mountains and through Knoxville into Nashville, Tennessee. Nashville is "Music City USA" and is known for its good-time, foot-stompin', guitar-pickin' fun. Nashville is home of the Grand Ole Opry and offers the best in live country music. Other attractions include Opryland USA, the Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum, Barbara Mandrell Country, and Andrew Jackson's home. "The Hermitage".

Day 08 – Nashville, TN – Memphis, TN

Today's travel takes you southwest to Memphis, best known as the "Home of the Blues". This American art form was created at the turn of the century by W.C. Handy, on Baele Street. The featured attraction is Graceland, home of the "King of Rock 'n Roll", where Elvis Presley immortalized the Memphis Sound. City highlights include the Martin Luther King Memorial, Pink Palace Museum and Mud Island, which all portray the history of the town by the Mississippi River.

Day 09 – Memphis, TN – Natchez, MS

Depart Memphis to Natchez and see the flourishing cotton trade and the favorable locations of "Old Man River" that made fortunes. Over 5000 antebellum homes and buildings are still standing and grace the streets of Natchez. Natchez Under-the-Hill is a quaint river landing district of shops, restaurants, and riverboat gambling.

Overnight: Holiday Inn Express or similar

Day 10 – Natchez, MS – New Orleans, LA

This morning's drive hugs the Mississippi River, lined with cotton and sugar plantations. Many of the gracious plantation homes still stand and may be visited. The route will lead you through Louisiana's state capitol, Baton Rouge, a booming port where sugar and oil dominate. Continue to Creole and Cajun Country - New Orleans. The city's French Quarter bursts with exciting sounds and smells, beautifully preserved buildings adorned with iron-lace balconies, antique shops, the toe-tapping beat of Dixieland jazz, gumbo and jambalaya.

Overnight: Holiday Inn New Orleans Downtown Superdome or similar

Day 11 – New Orleans, LA

Full day to explore this charming city. Walk the French Quarter, visit Royal Street, Bourbon Street, Jackson Square, the above-ground cemeteries and the many museums.

Day 12 – New Orleans, LA – Houston, TX

Leave Cajun country and cross the Sabine River into Texas. The oil refineries of Beaumont and Port Arthur will be proof that you are entering the heart of the source of Texas Tea - the city of Houston. Here you will find NASA on a 1,620-acre site, about 22 miles from the city. Visitors may become "insiders" at Space Center Houston with live demonstrations, live coverage of ongoing missions, film, exhibits, space artifacts and a Skylab tour.

Day 13 – Houston, TX – Dallas, TX

Today your travels will take you northwest passing many lakes and forests to the country's seventh largest city with an exquisite skyline, Dallas. The city was made popular by the television show of the same name. To outsiders, Dallas displays all of the characteristics associated with Texas - affluence, everything larger than life size, and individualism. Enjoy city sightseeing upon arrival. See the Book Depository, where the fatal shot was fired that killed JFK, Reunion Tower and the Market District.
