

DAY 01: Chicago, IL

Transfer to your Chicago hotel and spend the afternoon discovering the Windy City. This city offers excellent cultural and sports activities. This evening, try a famous Chicago-style pizza and afterwards check out some of the many famous Chicago Blues or Jazz clubs.

Overnight: Chicago Essex Inn or similar



DAY 02: Chicago, IL - Madison, WI

Begin your morning with a walking tour of Chicago, noted for its architecture, including the Loop, shopping the "Magnificent Mile" of Michigan Avenue and walking along the Lakefront of Lake Michigan. This afternoon drive to Madison, the capital of Wisconsin, with beautiful lakeside views.

DAY 03: Madison, WI - Minneapolis/St. Paul, MN

Continue your travels across Wisconsin, America's freshwater playground, to the Twin Cities. Suggested stops along the way include Baraboo, to visit the Circus World Museum, and the resort town of the Wisconsin Dells. Here boat and duck tours of the Wisconsin River offer magnificent views of the Sandstone bluffs of the Lower and Upper Dells.

DAY 04: Minneapolis, MN - Grand Rapids, MN

Today travel north through the "Land of 10,000 Lakes" to Grand Rapids, MN. Nestled in tall timber on the western edge of the Mesabi Iron Range, Grand Rapids, the birthplace of Judy Garland, is rich with the dual heritage of iron mining and logging.

DAY 05: Grand Rapids, MN - Ashland, WI

Return to Wisconsin to Bayfield, the gateway to the Apostle Islands National Lakeshore, a magnificent natural wilderness region. A cruise among the islands of Lake Superior, the largest body of fresh water in the world will give you a memorable and lasting impression of this unspoiled area. Later today, take a ferry to Madeline Island, the largest of the Apostle Islands to tour the old trading post and Indian burial grounds.

DAY 06: Ashland, WI - Marquette, MI

Today travel into Michigan and explore the picturesque Keweenaw Peninsula. See historic Fort Wilkens and visit the Delaware Copper Mine before continuing by the L'Anse Indian Reservation to Marquette.

DAY 07: Marquette, MI - St. Ignace, MI

Follow scenic State Road 28 to Munising. Take a cruise into Lake Michigan past the Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore to view the sandstone cliffs, caves, arches and columns. Afterwards drive to Tahquamenon Falls State Park near Newberry to view two striking waterfalls on the Tahquamenon River before arriving at St. Ignace.

DAY 08: St. Ignace, MI - Detroit, MI

Journey through Michigan to Detroit, home of Motown and Motor City, USA. Stay in nearby Dearborn, home of the Henry Ford Museum and Greenfield Village. This living history museum explores the industrial revolution and achievements of famous Americans such as the Wright Brothers and Thomas Edison.

DAY 09: Detroit, MI - Toronto, ONT

Today you will leave the United States for Canada as you drive along the shores of Lake Erie through Ontario for the cosmopolitan city of Toronto located on the shores of Lake Ontario. While in Toronto visit the CN Tower, the Skydome, Parliament Buildings, and shop at Eaton Place or the upscale shops of Bloor Street.

DAY 10: Toronto, ONT - Niagara Falls, NY

Drive to Niagara Falls through Ontario's wine-growing region and stop at the charming town of Niagara-on-the-Lake. Begin your tour viewing Niagara Falls from the Canadian side and ride on the "Maid of the Mist" through the thundering waterfalls to the basin of Horseshoe Falls.

Today you will drive into Indiana, the "Hoosier State." Visit the Northern Indiana Amish community, then continue to South Bend, home of the world famous Notre Dame University.
