

DAY 01: Los Angeles, CA

Transfer to your San Los Angeles hotel and the remainder of the day at leisure.

Overnight: Hilton Los Angeles Airport or similar

Day 02: Los Angeles, CA – Las Vegas, NV

Your tour begins today as you travel to Las Vegas via the Ghost Town of Calico. As you arrive in Las Vegas you will have time for a short tour of the city of lights. You will see everything from a working volcano to a pirate battle, in this city that has become a favorite vacation destination for all ages, even those not old enough to enjoy it's many famous casinos will find something to suit their interests in this rapidly growing city.

Overnight: Luxor or similar



Day 03: Las Vegas, NV – Death Valley, CA

Spend your morning at leisure sunning by the pool or taking in a flight to the Grand Canyon. This afternoon you will travel through the high desert on your way to one of the hottest places on earth, Death Valley. Death Valley is a place of incredible contrast, dipping from sea level to great heights as you travel the stretch that killed many pioneers on their way west.

Overnight: Furnace Creek Ranch

Day 04: Death Valley, CA – Mammoth Lakes, CA

Today travel north to Mammoth Lakes, one of California's most popular four-season resorts, this area provides access to the recreational facilities and points of interest in the Inyo National Forest. 200,000 acres contain portions of the Pacific Coast Trail, the John Muir Trail, Devils's Postpile National Monument, Mammoth Mountain ski area, and the Mammoth City historical site.

Overnight: Mammoth Mountain Inn

(Please Note: During the winter months (October - June) the Tioga Pass may be closed due to weather conditions. In such case, you will overnight in Visalia and traveling to Mammoth Lakes will not be possible)

Day 05: Mammoth Lakes, CA – Oakhurst, CA

Your journey continues to Yosemite National Park - The great falls which tumble into the Yosemite Valley are fed by the melting snow. From Glacier Point, you may see pinnacles, waterfalls and the tremendous Half Dome. The Park also contains the Mariposa and Toulumne groves of giant Sequoia.

Overnight: Comfort Inn Oakhurst or similar

Day 06: Oakhurst, CA – Monterey/Carmel, CA

Today you will coach to one of the most beautiful spots on the west coast, Monterey, the capitol of Alta California under the Spanish, Mexican and American Flags, Monterey lies on the Monterey Peninsula and ranges in its altitude from sea level to 360 feet. The peninsula is a popular year-round playground boasting several golf courses. On Cannery Row,



the colorful locale of John Steinbeck's Novel "Cannery Row" and "Sweet Thursday", galleries, shops and restaurants have replaced the fish canneries. Along Fisherman's Wharf, an art gallery, handicraft shops and the Wharf Theatre have superseded the commercial fishing activities of the early 20th century.

Overnight: Carmel Mission Inn or similar

Day 07: Monterey/Carmel, CA – San Francisco, CA

Your trip continues north along the California coast to one of the favorite cities of both Americans and visitors to this country, San Francisco. The city is comparatively young, yet seldom is there found a greater passion for the preservation of the past with all its colorful legends and architecture. This spirit is evident in the preservation of historic buildings as well as the famous cable cars. Varying in altitude from seal level to 929 feet, the city rests on 40 hills at the tip of a narrow peninsula bounded on one side by the Pacific Ocean and on the other side by San Francisco Bay, one of the largest land locked harbors in the world. Enjoy city sightseeing upon arrival, see Fisherman's Wharf, Union Square, Chinatown, the Golden Gate Bridge, the Bay Bridge and North Beach - San Francisco's "Little Italy".

Overnight: Holiday Inn Civic Center or similar



Day 08: San Francisco, CA – Reno, NV

This morning you will leave the Pacific Gateway and travel to the resort town of Reno - known as "The Biggest Little City in the World". Enjoy your evening in this little town that is full of stage shows and gambling establishments that operate 24 hours a day.

Overnight: Circus Circus Hotel & Casino or similar

Day 09: Reno, NV – Sierra Nevada Mountains – Twin Falls, ID

Today's travels will take you through the beautiful Sierra Nevada Mountains. Travel through the small gambling towns of Winnemucca and Elko. At Twin Falls, see Shoshone Falls at 212 feet, it is 52 feet taller than Niagara Falls.

Overnight: Best Western Plus Twin Falls Hotel or similar

Day 10: Twin Falls, ID – Yellowstone National Park, WY

As the journey continues you will reach the state of Wyoming and Yellowstone National Park, the first national park in the United States. This is the land of hot springs, limestone terraces and jagged peaks.

Overnight: Days Inn West Yellowstone or similar

**Day 11: Yellowstone National Park, WY – Cody, WY**

Today you will reach the part of the country that still boasts wild roaming buffalos. The final destination of the day is Cody, named after Buffalo Bill Cody. The statue of Buffalo Bill Cody seated on his horse "Smoky" is the nucleus of the noted Buffalo Bill Historical Center. If opportunity permits the Buffalo Bill Historical Center should not be missed!

Overnight: Holiday Inn Cody at Buffalo Bill Village

Day 12: Cody, WY – Rapid City, SD

This morning you will leave Wyoming and head north to the state of South Dakota, home to the famous statue Mount Rushmore, which is the colossal, sculpted heads of George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Abraham Lincoln, and Theodore Roosevelt. Created under the direction of Gutzon Borglum, the memorial is one of the largest pieces of sculpture ever created. Borglum intended to sculpt the presidents down to the waist, but died before completing the sculpture and no further work was done. Your destination today is Rapid City.

Overnight: Howard Johnson Inn & Suites or similar

Day 13: Rapid City, SD – Sioux City, IA

The Badlands National Park stretches out before you on your drive today. Items discovered in rich fossil beds of pre-historic remains are at the Ben Reifel Visitor Center and along the fossil trail. Continuing east, you will cross the seemingly endless plains of South Dakota to the state of Iowa, crossing the cornfields of this farming state, you will reach Sioux City.

Overnight: Holiday Inn Sioux City or similar

Day 14: Sioux City, IA – Chicago, IL

Today you will leave the farmlands of Iowa and cross into the state of Illinois, home of the “Windy City” Chicago. The city did not gain its nickname because of strong winds, but rather because of its rather boisterous politicians. The first skyscrapers were built here and many of the most striking examples may be found. See Sears Tower, the tallest building in the world, and the John Hancock Center and the Amoco Building which rival in height.

Overnight: Chicago Essex Inn or similar

Day 15: Chicago, IL – Detroit, MI

This morning’s drive will take you along Lake Michigan to the city of Detroit where the largest numbers of cars are built. The city is full of attractions and museums that include the People Mover, an enclosed, computerized, 2.94-mile transportation system, Belle Isle and the Motown Museum are just to name a few.

Overnight: Quality Inn or similar

Day 16: Detroit, MI – Toronto, ON

This morning you will leave the United States and cross the border into Canada, it’s neighbor to the north. After a relaxing drive through the province of Ontario, you will reach Toronto, the second largest city in Canada. As you drive through this lovely city, you will have a chance to get a glimpse of the CN Tower, one of Toronto’s claims to fame. A brief city tour will be given upon arrival to include, Old and New City Halls, the Financial District, Toronto’s Eaton Center, Chinatown, Yorkville Village, Fashion District, The Ontario Parliament Building and the Casa Loma.

Overnight: Sheraton Centre or similar

Day 17: Toronto, ON – Niagara Falls, ON

Today you will travel over the Welland Canal and the Niagara River and then stop to take in the awesome beauty of the Niagara Falls. Many daredevils have risked life and limb to try and go over the falls in such unorthodox conveyances as a wooden barrel. You will then cross back over the border into the United States and entering New York State you will soon reach Niagara Falls on the US side, the next stop on your trip.

Overnight: Days Inn & Suites Niagara Falls Centre Street



Day 18: Niagara Falls, ON – Washington, DC

Your destination today will take you through many of the showplaces of American history. As you make your way toward the nation's capital you will come through Gettysburg, home to the famous speech made by Abraham Lincoln, and the site of the deciding battle of the Civil War.

Overnight: Washington Hilton or similar

Day 19: Washington, DC – New York, NY

On your journey to New York you will have a chance to see some of the sights of the nation's capital, the Pentagon, the White House, and Arlington Cemetery. Then you will leave the District of Columbia and continue on through the state of Pennsylvania and Philadelphia, the "City of Brotherly Love". Then it's on through the Garden State, New Jersey to New York City, your final destination on your trip. Home to one of the most famous skylines in the world, New York will impress you with its sheer size and diversity as you travel through its streets to your hotel.
